## **COVID-19 [UPDATE 22.9.20]**

With the Government announcement on Tuesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2020 the following becomes law with effect from Thursday, 24<sup>th</sup> September 2020:

## **Face Coverings:**

- Customers in hospitality venues must wear face coverings, except when seated at a table to eat or drink. Staff in hospitality and retail will now also be required to wear face coverings (from 24 September).
- People who are already exempt from the existing face covering obligations, such as because of an underlying health condition, will continue to be exempt from these new obligations.
- Guidance stating that face coverings and visors should be worn in close contact services will now become law (from 24 September).

<u>Clubhouse, Professional Shop and Sir Sidney's Hut</u> - Face coverings will now be required at all times when inside the clubhouse and Sir Sidney's Hut but may be removed only once you are seated, or when asked to do so by a member of staff for communication purposes. Face coverings will also be required when you are using the professional shop.

## **Clubhouse Service:**

• Businesses selling food or drink (including cafes, bars, pubs and restaurants), social clubs, casinos, bowling alleys, amusement arcades (and other indoor leisure centres or facilities), funfairs, theme parks, adventure parks and activities, and bingo halls, must be closed between 10pm and 5am. This will include takeaways but delivery services can continue after 10pm (from 24 September).

- In licensed premises, food and drink must be ordered from, and served at, a table.
- Customers must eat and drink at a table in any premises selling food and drink to consume indoors, on site (from 24 September).
- Businesses will need to display the official NHS QR code posters so that customers can 'check-in' at different premises using this option as an alternative to providing their contact details once the app is rolled out nationally (from 24 September).

As the law now states you <u>must be seated</u> to purchase food or drink <u>[no standing]</u>; a member of staff will come to your table and take your order. Payment will be made at the table and this may be by your own personal <u>member card</u> [please show the member of staff your card who will note the card number]; you may be required to top up your account by debit/credit card/cash. If you do not have your card with you your order will be completed on to a kitty card as has been the norm over the last few months. <u>Please be patient at the busier times.</u>

**Rule of 6** — we do appreciate that the **Rule of 6** doesn't quite fit in to the club's seating arrangements. As previously stated, where possible seating is provided for a **maximum of 4 people [inside and outside]**, additional tables have been positioned in the lounge - some are tables of 2. If required due to inclement weather the **spike bar** has six individual tables available for six people maximum to be seated [**please do not move the tables around or stand in this area**]. Terrace - the taped off seating areas outside should not be used under any circumstance as this **does not conform to the minimum social distancing** requirements. With the changes to the law **it now will not be** possible to stand outside as previously notified.

To ensure that all members have an opportunity to have a drink, especially at the busier times, it may be that you will only be <u>permitted to stay for a limited time</u> [This was previously notified to members at the time of re-opening on the 8<sup>th</sup> July 2020]. If you are asked to vacate your table by the staff please do so without delay.

Thank you for your continued co-operation during these challenging times we are all facing.
