UPDATE – Tee Reservations

Dear Member

Further to the update to the tee reservations from 2-ball to 4-ball on Monday, 1st June 2020 the Board have had chance to look at the system now in place along with feedback from the membership.

The current system is:

- Members can book up to 17 days in advance, each day being released at 12 noon.
- 4 'live' bookings per member
- Members may call the club and book for that day and up to 12 noon on the following day, these bookings are to allow a degree of flexibility for last minute ad-hoc golf

The following will now be in place with immediate effect:

- Members can book up to 12 days in advance, each day being released at 12 noon [this is to take away the confusion/frustration over the use of 'live' bookings]. All current tee sheets will remain visible and Sunday, 28th June 2020 will now become available on Tuesday, 16th June 2020.
- 6 'live' bookings per member [this is to give each member more opportunity to effectively plan their golf] essentially, depending on when you like to play, you can now book every other day based on the 12 day cycle.
- Members may call the club and book for that day and up to 12 noon on the following day, these bookings are to allow a degree of flexibility for last minute ad-hoc golf
- Members guests** will be permitted at the following times and charges
 - Weekday; 10am to 4pm (maximum of 3 guests) at £35.00 per guest
 - Weekend/Bank Holiday; after 12pm (maximum of 3 guests) at £40.00 per guest

**Please arrange to meet your guest in the car park area before proceeding to the terrace and do stress the importance of the social distancing measures the club have put in place for everyone's safety. Please pay your guest green fees when you are in zone 2.

Restrictions on guest timings may vary subject to the recommencing of competitions which the Greens Committee are reviewing.

Visitors to the club may be introduced on a restrictive basis following this re-introduction of member's guests.

Thank you for your continued support during the re-opening process and maintaining social distancing measures in place.
